THE JOURNEY

Package Overview

★★★★ SEMI-LUXURY SAFARI & CRATER

This seven-day journey follows Tanzania's classic northern safari circuit, from the elephant herds of Tarangire to the endless plains of the Serengeti and the volcanic depths of the Ngorongoro Crater. Guests spend three nights following wildlife across central Serengeti before descending into the crater itself in search of the Big Five.

Travel is by private 4×4 safari vehicle with a professional driver-guide throughout, with picnic lunches served in the parks during game drives. Accommodation is a hand-picked mix of a comfortable town lodge, a private highland lodge, and a tented safari camp.

DAY BY DAY

Your Itinerary

DAY

1

Arrival in Tanzania

Land at Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) and meet your driver-guide for the road transfer to Arusha, roughly ninety minutes, with views of Mount Meru and Kilimanjaro on clear days.

Accommodation: Outpost Lodge

Meal Plan: Half Board

DAY

2

Arusha to Tarangire — Karatu

After breakfast, board your private 4x4 land cruiser with pop-up roof for the two-and-a-half-hour drive to Tarangire National Park, famed as the home of elephant and giant baobab trees. Enjoy a game drive with a picnic lunch in the park, then continue in the late afternoon to Karatu.

Accommodation: Octagon Lodge

DAY

3

Into the Serengeti

Depart after breakfast for Serengeti National Park, Tanzania's largest and oldest park and one of the most complex ecosystems on earth. Search the Seronera Valley for lion, leopard, cheetah, and hyena alongside elephant, zebra, giraffe, and wildebeest, with a picnic lunch taken during game viewing.

Accommodation: Serengeti Queens Camp

Meal Plan: Full Board

DAY

4

Full Day — Central Serengeti

An early departure into the heart of central Serengeti, through the Seronera region's grassy plains, rocky kopjes, and winding rivers. Spend the day following predators and herds of wildebeest, zebra, and gazelle, with waterholes drawing elephant, hippo, and rich birdlife.

Accommodation: Serengeti Queens Camp

DAY

5

Full Day — Central Serengeti

A second full day exploring the plains and riverine areas of central Serengeti at a relaxed pace, watching the interplay between predators and prey across the open savannah and scattered kopjes, with a picnic lunch out on the plains.

Accommodation: Serengeti Queens Camp

Meal Plan: Full Board

DAY

6

Central Serengeti to Ngorongoro Crater

Leave the Serengeti after breakfast and drive south through the scenic Ngorongoro Conservation Area, passing rolling highlands and Maasai villages. Descend into the crater for a game drive in search of lion, elephant, buffalo, rhino, and hippo, before returning to Karatu for the night.

Accommodation: Octagon Lodge

DAY

7

Departure

Enjoy a relaxed morning, with the option of a brief visit to a nearby coffee plantation, before transferring through scenic farmland to Kilimanjaro International Airport in time for your onward flight.

A tented camp in the scenic Kimarishe woodland, surrounded by acacia trees just twenty-four kilometres from Seronera. Tents overlook a landscape where wildlife gathers at the waterhole, offering an authentic taste of outdoor African living.

THE DESTINATIONS

A Land of Three Worlds

Arusha

Sitting beneath Mount Meru and within sight of Kilimanjaro, Arusha is Tanzania's safari capital and a key international diplomatic hub, hosting the East African Community headquarters. Its elevation of 1,400 metres keeps the climate cool and pleasant year-round, making it a gentle introduction to the country.

Karatu & the Ngorongoro Highlands

Beneath the extinct volcano of Ol Deani, Karatu marks the transition from the Manyara escarpment into cooler, greener highlands. Once a centre of coffee farming, it remains a popular overnight base for travellers heading to the Ngorongoro Crater.

Serengeti National Park

Tanzania's largest and most famous park, spanning nearly 14,763 square kilometres of open plains, acacia trees, and granite kopjes bordering Kenya's Maasai Mara. It hosts the annual wildebeest migration and reliable year-round sightings of lion, elephant, giraffe, and cheetah, with hot-air balloon safaris offering a unique perspective over the plains.

Days on safari are hot; nights and early morning game drives can be cool, so light, neutral-coloured clothing with a few warmer layers works best. Luggage space on safari vehicles is limited, so pack light — Arusha has shops and pharmacies for anything forgotten.

- ✦ Anti-malarial medication (consult your doctor)

- ✦ Sunhat, sunglasses & binoculars
- ✦ Universal power adapter
- ✦ First-aid basics: painkillers, antidiarrheal, hand sanitiser

- ✦ Sandals or flip-flops for the lodge
- ✦ Cotton clothing in light, neutral tones
